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WELCOME TO THE MISS / MISTER JUNETEENTH PAGEANT

Welcome to the Miss & Mister Juneteenth Pageants, presented by Northcott Neighborhood House!

This scholarship competition is open to African American young men and women ages 8 to 13. Miss and Mister Juneteenth showcases young women & young men:

- Academic achievements.
- Service to the community.
- Talents in the written, visual, and performing arts.

For 2022, the Miss & Mister Juneteenth Pageants will be held in June, 2022. As a contestant, you will compete for up to \$3000.00 in cash, prizes, and scholarships. In addition to the prizes, Miss & Mister Juneteenth and his/her court will be prominently featured in the Juneteenth Day Parade and Celebration on Sunday, June 19, 2022. Young men & women from our inaugural Little Miss Juneteenth & Mister Juneteenth Jr. will be part of the parade too. Above all, Northcott Neighborhood House desires the pageants to be a positive experience for all entrants.

How to Enter:

You must submit a completed application along with the following information:

1. A 250-word essay on the question; "How do I maximize the opportunities afforded me today because of those who sacrificed before me?"
2. Proof of age (copy of photo ID with date of birth)
3. A copy of your most recent card and transcript (Applicant must carry a minimum of a 2.5 GPA)



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What to Expect as a Contestant:

For Miss & Mister Juneteenth, judges will evaluate you on the following:

1. Poise and Personality
2. Talent (Creativity and Performance)
3. Evening Wear (Afro-Centric w/Essay Reading)
4. Interview Questions

What to Expect as Miss or Mister Juneteenth:

You are regarded as an exceptional young man / woman and role model for all of Milwaukee's youth. During your year-long reign, you are expected to:

- Promote positive images through school appearances and community events.
- Serve as a great source of pride to our youth striving to realize their potential as future leaders.

PAGEANT RULES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

As role models and positive examples of the hopes and dreams of our ancestors, contestants are expected to conduct themselves in a way that will bring honor and pride in our community, as well as not do acts that would bring shame to themselves or the title of Miss/Mister Juneteenth.

Please Read and Review the Following:

Little Miss Juneteenth & Mister Juneteenth Junior Requirements:

- All entrants must submit a 250-word essay that focuses on the theme, "How do I maximize the opportunities afforded me today because of those who sacrificed before me?"
 - Entrants must use the City of Milwaukee Library System to develop their essay.
 - A copy of your birth certificate and school ID are required.
 - Be a Milwaukee County resident for at least six months.



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Participants Must Have:

- An upstanding reputation in the community and not involved in illegal activities have no legal issues pending, have no convictions of misdemeanors or felonies.
- Not have a child or be expecting a child submitting the application. Applicants cannot become pregnant during their title reign. This will be grounds of forfeiture of her crown and the first runner-up will complete the term.
- Are to be in good physical health. If you have medical issue or concern, please notify the pageant coordinator and make a note of it on your application. Your information will be held privately.
- Notify the pageant coordinators if there is any change of address or issues that might affect the pageant.

Juneteenth Responsibilities Participants are:

- To sell a minimum of \$100.00 of advertisements and/or ticket sales.
- Have a minimum grade point average of 2.5 or higher.
- Submit a completed application packet and have the written consent (signature) of their parent or legal guardian before participating in the Juneteenth pageant program.
- To attend all rehearsals, which are mandatory. If an emergency does arise (medical), please notify the pageant coordinators. Conflicting dates for school, work and any other extra-curricular activity do count as emergencies.

You are expected to use time management to meet personal and pageant obligations.

- Should there be any unexcused absences from rehearsals, you automatically forfeit your spot in the pageant.
- There will only be up to 10 young men & women competing on pageant day. (Subject to change at the discretion).
