- An Application and Participation Agreement (included with this packet) must be submitted by May 13, 2022, with payment.

- Northcott Neighborhood House and the Juneteenth Planning Committee, reserves all rights to record and reproduce video, audio, music, and digital images of the parade event for both publication and unrestricted distribution.

2022 Juneteenth Jubilee Floats Regulations

- Participants are responsible for ensuring that every part of the float is secure.
- **Items prohibited on floats or trucks/cars include, fire, live animals, smoke machines, dry ice, firearms, and explosives.**
- The Juneteenth Parade Committee will be inspecting the floats the day of the parade to ensure safety requirements are met. A second follow-up inspection will be performed at line-up on the day of the parade. All entries must pass inspection by the committee. Time slots for inspections will be provided.

2022 Juneteenth COVID-19 Responsibility Agreement

- o Stay at least 6 feet away from people who don't live with them.
- o Find additional information below about how to modify layouts and maintain healthy environments.
- o All attendees must wear well-fitting masks covering over their nose and mouth.
- o The following categories of people are exempt from the requirement to wear a mask:
 - A child under the age of 2 years.
 - A person with a disability who cannot wear a mask, or cannot safely wear a mask, for reasons related to the disability.
 - A person for whom wearing a mask would create a risk to workplace health, safety, or job duty as determined by the workplace.
- o Require staff and attendees to wash their hands and/or use hand sanitizer frequently (for example, before, during, and after each encounter with a person or handling material).
- o Ensure that you have adequate supplies to have healthy hygiene.
- o Supplies include: soap, water, hand sanitizer, a way to dry hands (e.g., paper towels), tissues, disinfectant wipes, and masks.
- o Northcott Neighborhood House 51st Juneteenth Jubilee Parade, Juneteenth Street Festival and Juneteenth Concert is Sunday, June 19, 2022.
- o We must have a COVID-19 Responsibility Agreement on file in preparedness.
